We have observed that one is more likely to sustain serious injury on a motorcycle than in a automobile. In a car accident, the vehicles often have roll bars and crumple zones that can keep you safer than if there were no barriers at all. Cars have many safety features including seat belts, to prevent being ejected from a vehicle at the time of an accident. When riding a motorcycle, there is no barrier established at all between you and the outside. Also, there is no safety feature installed on a motorcycle. In the event of a motorcycle accident, you can be thrown from the motorcycle and seriously injured.

Automobiles are always receiving new safety features in the event of an accident to prevent injuries or death. For instance, now many vehicles have air bags on the drivers side and passengers side of a vehicle to help to prevent the driver and/or passenger from receiving serious injuries from an auto accident.

When an accident occurs between a motorcycle and a vehicle, the motorcyclist usually receives the more serious injuries. Motorcycles are smaller than vehicles and are more difficult to see on the roadway at night time. If you receive injuries from a motorcycle accident and you are not at fault, it is possible to receive compensation for your injuries.
